



2019 GOLF LEAGUE PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES AND AGREEMENT

By choosing to play in a golf league at a City of Calgary golf course I agree to the following:

Attendance:

As a member of a golf league I am expected and obligated to honour my scheduled tee time.
If I cannot schedule my other life events outside of the league schedule, I will not sign up to play that day.
I understand that I may call the clubhouse to cancel on the day of the golf league only when I am within 2 hours of my tee time and something unexpected arises at the last minute. This does not include weather (see below).
Any changes to league schedules more than 2 hours in advance of my tee time are to be communicated through my golf league and not the clubhouse.
When golfing in a league I understand that it is best to check in 30 minutes before my tee time, and that our liaison may adjust tee times and foursomes to manage spots left open by last minute cancellations, or no shows, within the group.
While individual leagues may impose penalties, including financial costs, on players who do not check in for a scheduled tee time, I understand this is a league executive decision and The City of Calgary does charge or collect green fees when I do not check in.
I understand it is the responsibility of my league executive to release unneeded tee times in advance. By releasing unneeded tee times in advance and then checking in for all spaces still scheduled for the golf league, our group will meet the cancellation guidelines.
I understand that leagues are subject to size reduction and possible league cancellation if attendance guidelines are not met.

Rain / Weather

I will consider the forecast before signing up so that my executive can release unneeded tee times in advance.
Cancellation due to weather is based on conditions at the scheduled golf course at the time of the booking. Conditions can vary widely across the city.
My league executive will communicate with clubhouse staff to access current conditions and make the decision on behalf of the entire group to cancel, or not, approximately 2 hours before the scheduled start time.
Once the decision to cancel the reservation is made, my executive is responsible for communicating the cancellation to league players. I will refrain from calling the clubhouse and I will abide by the group decision.
If no communication is received I am to assume that play will go on as scheduled. I will accept the executive decision and arrive on time.
When a golf league is cancelled due to weather, but the course remains open, I know that I can still choose to play by reserving my own tee time online or by calling the clubhouse.
I understand that The City of Calgary does not require league players to arrive at a golf course on days when play has been cancelled in case weather improves, or to get credit for my attendance.

Pace-of-Play

<p>The game has been modernized and I will familiarize myself with the 2019 Rules of Golf. <u>golfcanada.ca/rules-of-golf/</u></p>
<p>I am aware that pace-of-play is everyone's responsibility and good pace comes from being efficient - not from rushing.</p>
<p>I am aware the pace-of-play listed on the score card is the <i>maximum</i> time to complete a round and that my pace-of-play is expected to be less than that maximum time.</p>
<p>I am aware that "behind pace" means I am more than a half hole behind the group ahead of mine and/or playing at more than the maximum pace per hole listed on the score card.</p>
<p>I will remain aware of my group's pace-of-play and if we fall behind, I will actively participate in catching up. This may require picking up our balls and moving to the next hole.</p>
<p>I will play ready golf. Including club selection, practice swing and lining up my shot: I will not take more than 40 seconds to hit my ball, including putts. The clock starts when the last person's ball stops rolling.</p>
<p>I am aware that I am only permitted 2 minutes to look for a lost ball (local rule), and that looking for a lost ball more than 3 times during a round will put my group behind pace.</p>
<p>Under no circumstances will I go back to the tee box to re-hit if my tee shot is lost and I did not hit a provisional ball (see rules modernization).</p>
<p>I will not blame things that are out of my control as reasons for being out of position, like weather and wayward shots, but I will focus on things that are within my control.</p>
<p>If I am respectfully asked to pick up the pace, I will not be offended. I will remain pleasant and help the group speed up play.</p>
<p>I am aware that if my group is behind pace and I am not conforming with pace-of-play expectations, that I may be placing my golf league group at risk according to the Pace of Play Guidelines.</p>

I know that my league executive is aware of these guidelines and are available to clarify information if needed.
